Before the war, Germany was a large exporter of capital, pursuing "Every police officer must always a policy of imperialist expansion bear in mind that failing to act is through direct seizure of colonies (Kiao-Chou, German West Africa, etc.), and through the possession of spheres of influence of more or less marked political flavor (China, Turkey, South America).

Since the war, it has been deprived of its colonies, and through the imposition of reparations was compelled to import capital from 1924 to 1929 instead of exporting it.
