letarian revolution, and the true expression of the aspirations of the workingclass, the Communist Parties, the parties of revolutionary socialism, must not be caught unaware by the impending world-events.

There will be influences at work to undermine your party and its influence upon the workers. The stronger you will become the greater will be the enmity, not only of the class whose destruction is spelled by your success, but also of those whom you would naturally expect to be friends of the working class. But let this not daunt you or swerve you from your path. Your enemies will be swept aside by the onslaught of the masses of the workers. Forward Comrades, to the Social Revolution.

In conclusion I assure you that as your party is the only one in Mexico which is proletarian and revolutionary, when your delegate will present himself before the Bureau of the Third International he will be admitted with the full rights enjoyed by other representatives of the parties affiliated with the Third International. Meanwhile, upon my return to Moscow I shall lay the matter before the Bureau and when your delegate arrives your Party will already have been admitted. If there will be any chance to communicate with you, I shall see to it that you are informed of the proceedings of the Bureau.
