

democratic revolution begins only AFTER its victory, and that only then does petty-bourgeois influence become an obstacle to its further development. The struggle for this transformation and for the consolidation and development of forces guaranteeing this transformation must be carried on even in the period of preparation for the bourgeois democratic revolution (which does not thereby cease to be BOURGEOIS DEMOCRATIC); -- the most important element here is precisely the independence of the CPs from all bourgeois and petty bourgeois influence. But your formulations simply leaves out this question, and in a very confused manner directly permits petty bourgeois influence on the CPs in the period of bourgeois democratic revolution.

This must be corrected on the basis of the ~~критич~~ observations made by us, sending out to the CPs a special supplement to your circular.
