There seems to exist a certain provincialism and a grave lack of understanding that the defense of the Chinese people is an integral part of the defense of the Soviet Union. We shall undertake to correct these vital weaknesses. At the same time it might be advisable that the Political Commission of the ECCI shall make a direct appeal to the CC's of the Caribbean parties sending this appeal to us and we would transmit it to each CC with our own practical proposals on how best to put the appeal of the Political Commission into effect.

We shall send you regularly reviews and reports on the course of the anti-war campaign.
