ДОКУМЕНТЫ СОВЕТСКОЙ ЭПОХИ
TO THE CARIBBEAN BUREAU.

1. We have received several letters from you with various proposals, the carrying out of which calls for additional grants for your budget. Thus for example the proposal to send an instructor to Panama, to send two permanent instructors ^{for} ~~in~~ your staff etc.,

Unfortunately we must inform you that any additional grants are absolutely impossible before the end of the current budget year.

2. The number of students for the IIS has been reduced as compared with the original quota not only for the Caribbean countries, but for all of South and Central America as well. The number allowed you in the last assignment is final.

Comrade Vyanjel at the present time is in no condition (owing to his state of health) to be sent away for the time being.

In your thesis of August 1st, we wish to call your attention to a glaringly unfortunate formulation. It is stated that "the unemployed can get food only by means of the workers' and peasants' Revolution". Statements like this can weaken the energy of our CPs in their struggle for immediate relief to the unemployed, and make our chief demand for improving the situation of the unemployed, namely, "Insurance amounting to full wages at the expense of the government and the employers; absolutely meaningless. The thesis should have said that any radical improvement in the situation of the unemployed, as well as the abolishment of unemployment, can be achieved only through the vic-
