

in statements that "the Party cannot do anything because neither the CP nor the working class are prepared for power", at the same time you ought to have shown up another danger which is very characteristic of the CP of Cuba, the danger of the Left deviation and putschism which is expressed in the frequent slogans of general strikes, "permanent strikes" and especially in the slogan of the armed rebellion, of terrorist acts and the immediate formation of Soviets in October 1930.

d) For conspirative reasons, you should not have published the number of members of the illegal CP of Cuba.

e) For the same reasons, you should not have stated that the CP of Cuba has only a small proportion of natives, i.e. that the majority of the members of the CP are foreigners. In this way you make it possible for Machado and his clique, including the reformists, to justify their repeated statement that they are "not persecuting a CP of Cubans but a CP of foreigners". It would have been better to express it in another way, for instance, in the positive form:- "The CP of Cuba must increase the percentage of natives in her ranks". In addition your statement is not exactly correct. Apart from Havana, where there is a comparatively large proportion of foreigners in the CP, in the provinces the absolute majority consists of natives.
