which you did not repeat in your letter of June 15th. The letter to you written on May 5th and signed by Comrade S must be interpreted as a condemnation of this formula, and not as a condemnation of the idea of publishing a periodical.

About another erroneous formula -- "class of toilers" -- we have already written to you in our remarks regarding number one of "El Comunista".

The formulation and language of the periodical must be very carefully edited, because there is among our young comrades a superabundance of theoretical confusion of ideas, and the object of this periodical is to help with their correct Marxist-Leninist education.

5. One must take into consideration that in a series of countries (for instance Cuba, Venezuela) the periodical will not after all have broad legal possibilities of dissemination, in as far as apart from the language and the special terminology (for instance, "consistently revolutionary workers" instead of "U.P", etc.), its contents will be revolutionary. Therefore, it will be necessary:

a. To change its <sup>titles</sup> ~~titles~~ (to issued it may be in different covers for the various countries), and

b. To organise simultaneously with the legal dissemination also its illegal supply to the ~~native~~ Party and trade union organization.

6. For the time being, you must not depend on financial support for the periodical from here, and must therefore raise the necessary means yourselves.

7. Please keep us informed about the preparations you are making for the publication of the periodical, and about your plans in connection with it.
